Brief Event Itinerary

Friday 2 July – Formal Dinner

The venue is the Wolston Park Golf Club. We start at 6.00pm with platters of canapes followed by two sit-down alternate drop courses. Includes complimentary coffee and tea. Drinks can be purchased from the bar. Entertainment by the Irish band Silken Thomas and virtuoso flautist Robin Etter-Cleave. This event has been heavily subsidized by the Club, so you pay only **\$45 pp** plus you will receive several items of memorabilia.

By signing this form, participants in the Grand Display of French Cars event, undertake to comply with the directions of the host organising club (2021 Renault Car Club of Queensland Inc). This includes but is not limited to:

- Ensuring that their vehicle is insured under CTP insurance or equivalent public liability insurance before bringing it into Murarrie Recreation Reserve. Vehicles which are trailered but not insured, must remain on the trailer.
- Follow the directions of all *On-Ground* martials and officials.
- Parking as directed in the locations designated.
- **Cross the cycle track** at the designated location and not drive along or beside the track.
 - Access to all areas in the display area is via the grass field behind the display area.
- Give way to all bicycle riders and pedestrians at all times. Speed limit in the park is a slow walking pace.
- Once in the park, vehicles are not to be driven around the grounds. No joy rides.
- On leaving the Reserve at the end of day, leave via the grass following the same route you entered via.
- Please turn left only out of the Reserve onto Wynnum Road to minimise holding up exiting traffic.
